

Table Centerpiece Ideas

Decorative Vase:

Buy an inexpensive vase (KMART, TJ Maxx, etc.) The straighter the sides are the easier it will be to apply decorations. Print names on colored paper or clear labels. You can glue the paper to the vase with decoupage glue or watered down school glue. I glued back then applied a top coat all over the vase to protect the paper better. If you hand write the names be sure to use something that won't be affected by the water based glue. Crayons or permanent markers will work.

You can then arrange silk greens or a seasonal arrangement inside the container and enjoy! Make sure you don't cover the names.

You can also use plates and place the names around the edge and use it as a candle holder or plant saucer.

River Rocks:

Rocks are available at a garden center such as Lexington Gardens in Newtown and The Garden in Woodbury. You can also collect rocks from your yard or on a hike (check posted signs for rules) Use a permanent marker to write the names on the stones then arrange on your prayer table at the base of the cross.
